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Investment Opportunities in Krosno

Dear Investors,

On behalf of the City of Krosno, I am honored to extend an invitation to explore the exceptional investment opportunities our city offers.

Krosno is a city located in southeastern Poland, with a population of around 44,000. It serves as a regional center of economy, education, culture, and administration. Key industrial sectors include glassware manufacturing, aviation, automotive, infrastructure production for the oil and gas industry, plastics processing, and the furniture industry. More than 6,000 small and medium-sized enterprises play an important role in the city's economy. Krosno also offers well-prepared investment sites in highly attractive locations.

Krosno is ready to embrace ambitious projects. We offer attractive investment sites, continuously develop our technical infrastructure, and place strong emphasis on educating highly skilled workforce aligned with the needs of business. In the zone adjacent to Krosno Airport /EPKR/, we are offering 20 hectares dedicated to the aviation industry. In the new economic zone Krosno 2, we are currently preparing more than 100 hectares. I am convinced that this is an attractive location for investors considering projects in Poland. The area is covered by a spatial development plan and is situated near the S19 expressway and railway line no. 108. Advanced works are underway to fully equip this area with infrastructure and connect it to the city and the expressway.

Our investment support is complemented by a comprehensive system of services, particularly in developing human capital, including:

- Collaboration opportunities with the State Academy of Applied Sciences in Krosno, which offers engineering and master's programs and works closely with industry partners through dual studies.
- Cooperation with vocational secondary schools, educating over 3,000 students in Krosno, supported by state-of-the-art practical laboratories at the Regional Center for Vocational

Education and Modern Technologies. Krosno is home to two fully operational Skills Centers, providing advanced training for the aviation and oil & gas industries.

- Access to a broad labor pool, with more than 17,000 workers commuting to Krosno daily. The city is strategically positioned to draw talent from within a 45-minute commuting radius, serving nearly half a million residents. Public transport is well-developed, with both municipal and private operators. Following years of effort, the revitalization of railway line 108 and the construction of a rail connector shortening travel time from Rzeszów to Krosno are set to begin this year. As a result, employees will be able to travel to Krosno quickly and safely.
- A commitment to high-quality living standards to attract new residents, including skilled specialists employed by investors and local enterprises. The city offers the “Housing for Specialists” program, enabling qualified employees to rent apartments on preferential terms. Collaboration with the Krosno Housing Enterprise allows investors to secure housing for employees. Another ambitious project is the construction of a new model residential estate (ultimately around 1,800 apartments) located next to the Krosno 2 economic zone.
- Krosno offers corporate income tax exemptions under the Polish Investment Zone for up to 15 years, at the highest level of public aid available in the European Union. The city also provides property tax exemptions for up to 10 years.
- Investor services are conducted in accordance with the standards recommended by the Polish Investment and Trade Agency.
- Krosno is not only experiencing dynamic economic growth but also offers a wealth of leisure opportunities. Culture enthusiasts can enjoy numerous festivals, concerts, exhibitions, and other artistic events. Sports and recreation thrive here thanks to modern facilities and the proximity of mountain and spa areas.
